Ilana Landsberg-Lewis has spent her entire adult life engaged in the struggle for the rights of women and girls. From her early days as a human rights and labour lawyer to her years at United Nations Development Fund for Women (UNIFEM), Ilana has worked with women's groups around the world and has learned that no amount of so-called expertise can replace that of women at the frontlines of their own struggle for justice.

Ilana has been the executive director of the Stephen Lewis Foundation since she co-founded it in 2003 – a charitable foundation that has sent over \$100 million dollars (every penny raised) to sub-Saharan Africa, to community-based organizations at the frontlines of the AIDS pandemic.

Ilana's podcast, Grandmothers on the Move kicks old stereotypes to the curb, shining a spotlight on grandmothers around the world making vital contributions to their families and communities.

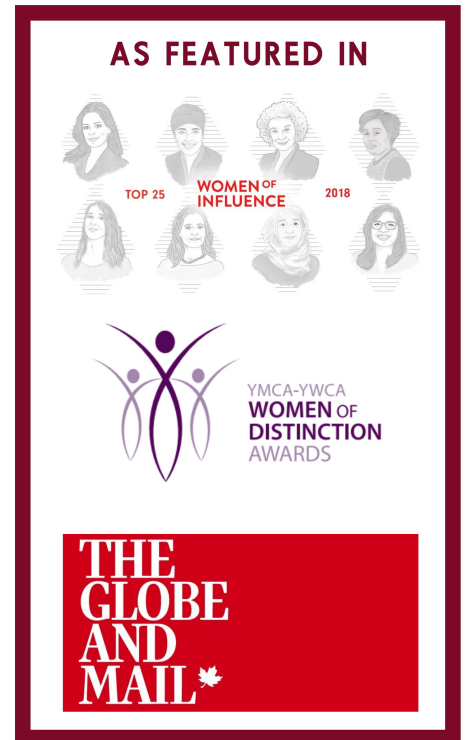
Value Add for the Audience: A roadmap for changing the way people think about giving-back, making a difference, and investing in social good.
